



## Satinlite - Lightest

**Thickness:** 3mm to 12mm (1/8" to 1/2")

**Dimensions:** Standard 96" x 130", other dimensions available on request

**Substrates:** Clear, low-iron, bronze, grey, blue and black

**Surface:** One side only, subject to minimum quantity.



## Satin - Light

**Thickness:** 3mm to 19mm (1/8" to 3/4")

**Dimensions:** Standard 96" x 130", other dimensions available on request

**Substrates:** Clear, low-iron, bronze, grey, blue and black

**Surface:** Available on both sides from 3mm to 8mm, subject to minimum quantity.



## Velour - Medium

**Thickness:** 3mm to 19mm (1/8" to 3/4")

**Dimensions:** Standard 96" x 130" and 100" x 144" for certain substrates

**Upsize:** 6mm available in 100" x 168" and 100" x 204" on clear and low-iron

**Substrates:** Clear, low-iron, bronze, grey, blue and black

**Surface:** Available on both sides from 3mm to 19mm, subject to minimum quantity.



## Opaque - Heaviest

**Thickness:** 3mm to 19mm (1/8" to 3/4")

**Dimensions:** 96" x 130", other dimensions available on request


**Substrates:** Clear, low-iron, bronze, grey, blue and black

**Surface:** Available on both sides from 3mm to 19mm, subject to minimum quantity.

Available with **Satin** or **Opaque** finishes on surface one, paired with a choice of Solarban® high-performance coatings from Vitro on surface two.
